It's that time of year again!

Springtime is time for your sweeper to go to work! Long days, heavy post-winter pick up and spring showers deposits heavy material on the streets. Towards the end of winter it is time to make sure your sweeper is 100% ready for one of the most difficult seasons to sweep. Follow these basic steps and your machine will be ready:

- Clean the machine from top to bottom
- Inspect and replace any rubber seals, gaskets, etc.
- Replace all brooms with Heavy-duty segments
- Check all side broom settings on a level surface to assure proper broom patterns
- Operate all sweep and dump functions while simultaneously inspecting for binding, broken parts, etc.
- Test the water system, clean and inspect all nozzles
- Completely drain all air tanks to remove any trapped moisture in the pneumatic valves
- Service the machine per the Operators Manual



Performance of the above eight steps will insure a well prepared machine for the spring sweeping season.
