### NEW VACTOR 2100i FOR CITY OF BELLEVILLE

The City of Belleville, Kansas purchased a new VACTOR® 2100i after Vince Deason, Key Equipment & Supply Company's Territory Manager, did a demonstration for the Utilities Director, Brian Phillips, and his team members. The VACTOR 2100i replaced Belleville's 20-year-old VAC-CON truck. The City of Belleville built the 2100i to their needs. They decided on a single axle truck with a 10-yard debris body and a 1000-gallon water capacity and a RDB boom coupled with Dual Hydro-excavation for larger jobs they will be doing. The 2100i is equipped with 600 feet of ¾ sewer hose and the pump is putting out 50 GPM up to 3000 PSI.
